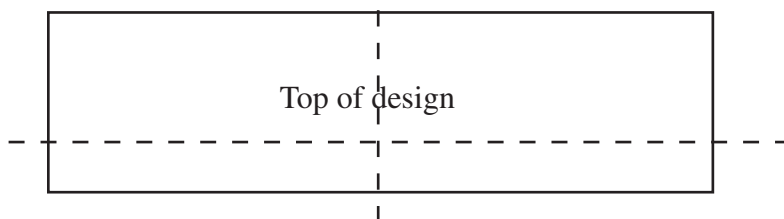
Supply List

- An embroidery machine if you wish to add the flag embroidery
- 4 Thread serger
- .3 m white polar fleece
- .2m red polar fleece (This will make 2 toques; if you wish to use one colour only, .3m will make one toque.)
- 4 cones serger thread
- Red and white 40 wt. rayon embroidery thread
- Bobbin thread for embroidery
- Cutaway Magic Stabilizer
- Water-soluble topping stabilizer

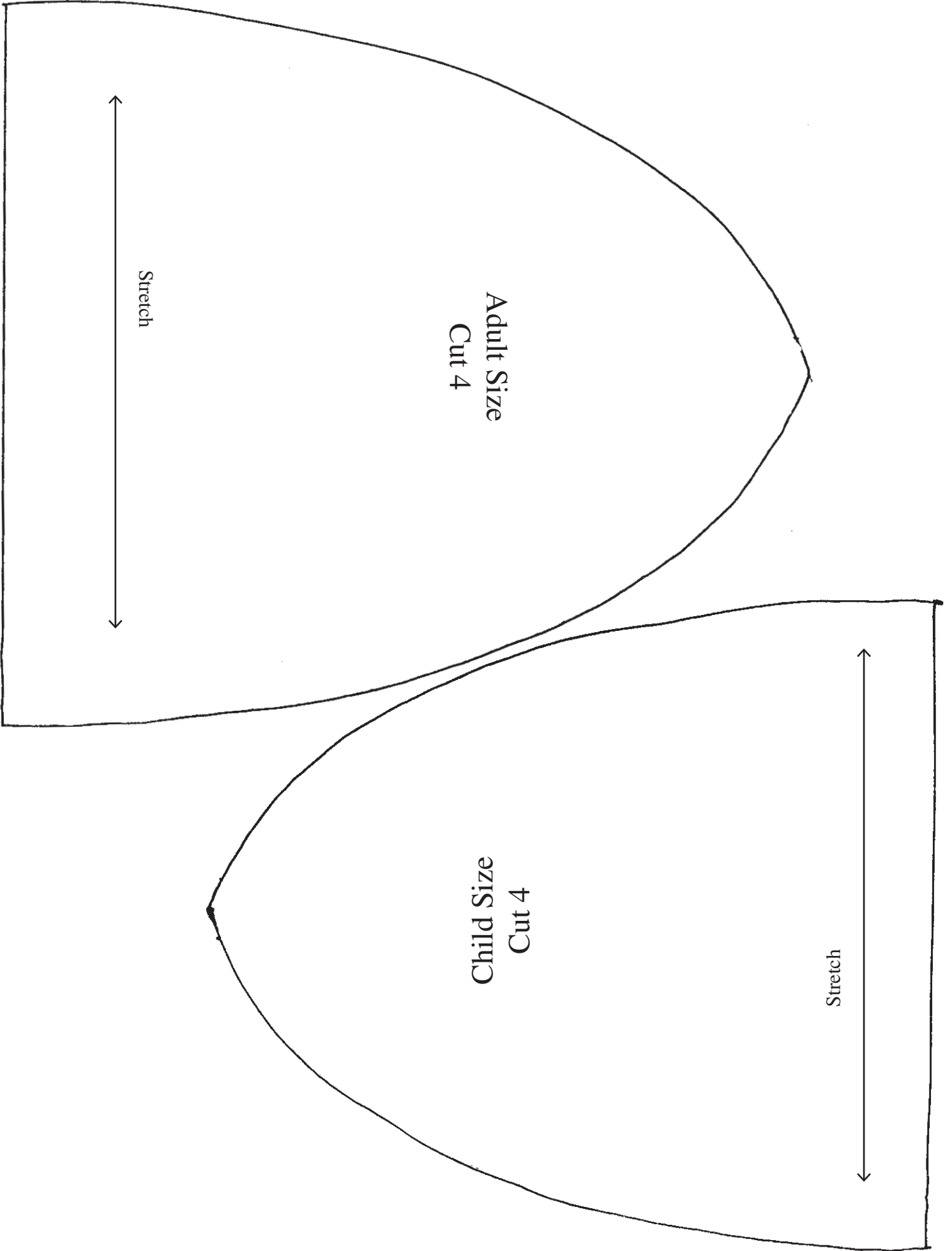
* Note - the adult sized pattern makes a Small/Medium adult size. To make larger, add 1/4" all around and cut a 11 1/2" x 24" strip for the band.

Sewing Instructions:

1. Using the pattern on page 2, cut four toque sections from red fleece.
2. Cut an 11" x 22" strip for adult size or a 9" x 20" strip for child size toque from white fleece.
3. Set your serger up for a 4 thread stitch and stitch the four red sections together into the crown of your toque.
4. To position your embroidery, using a water soluble marking pen, draw lines on your white fleece as shown below: Draw a centre vertical line and a horizontal line 3/4 down from top edge. The centre of your embroidery should be where these lines intersect.



5. Hoop your Cutaway stabilizer and position your white fleece on top with a layer of water soluble topping over the fleece. Stitch your design and cut away excess stabilizer.
6. Fold the white fleece in half, right sides together widthwise and serge raw edges together to form a tube.
7. Fold the tube in half wrong sides together to create the band for your toque. Position right sides together with the crown of your toque and serge together. The embroidery should be on the outside when you stitch so that when you flip the band back it shows on the band.
8. If desired, cut ten or twelve 1/4" x 6" strips of fleece for a tassel. Thread a hand sewing needle with a sturdy thread and wrap around the centre of your strips to tie them. Stitch into the top centre seam of the toque.
