



Chalk It Up!

Keep road trips and restaurants fun this summer with these easy to sew mats made just for kids!

For two mats you'll need:

.35m of chalk cloth
.15m for borders
.2m for binding
.35m for backing

Use 1/4" seams throughout.

Cut the chalk cloth into two rectangles each 12" x 18". Cut four 1 1/4" strips from the border fabric. With right sides together, matching long edges, sew a strip to each short side of each rectangle. Finger press to outside. Trim any excess.

Sew a border strip to the top and bottom of each of the rectangles. Finger press to outside. Trim excess.

Cut the backing into two rectangles each 14" x 20".

Place backing face down, then lay top face up over top.

Cut binding into four 2 1/4" strips. Join two strips for each mat.

Press binding in half lengthwise.

Place binding on top of mat matching raw edges.

Sew mitreing corners. Turn over and hand stitch down.

Add chalk and watch the fun!
