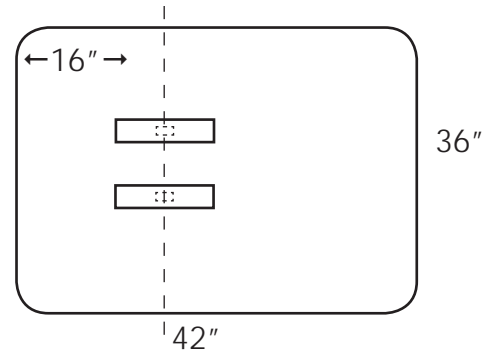


Swaddling Car Seat Cover

Make a lovely, lightweight, breathable and snugly car seat cover for the "Bambino" in your life!



Supplies:

- 1.3m each solid and print Bambino Gauze Fabric
- 7" x 8" piece of muslin or any similar cotton (to stabilize straps)
- Two pieces Hook & Loop Tape - 2½" x 2¾"

Instructions:

1. Measure your car seat or baby carrier. Finished cover should measure about 36" wide by 42" long depending on the size of the carrier.
2. Cut off two, 4 x 7" pieces of fabric from both solid and print for the straps and also from the stabilizing fabric. The straps need to be approx. 3½" x 6" finished.
3. Trim the gauze fabric to square up, using the lines on fabric as a guide. Optionally, round all four corners if desired.
4. Place the solid fabric under the print, right sides out and roll the edges of the solid over the print. Stitch all the way around with a decorative stitch.
5. Place the print and solid strap pieces right sides together on top of a piece of stabilizing cotton. Stitch all around on 3 sides, leaving one short end open to turn. Turn right side out, fold open edges in and sew all around with a decorative stitch to close up the opening and embellish the strap. Make two. Sew hook and loop tape to the ends of both straps.
6. Measure finished cover, placing straps 16" from one end and 5½" - 6" apart, centred. Sew a 1" x 2" long rectangle in the centre of strap to fasten to cover .
